This document sets out the policy of the Parochial Church Council of the Parish of St John and St Luke, Clay Hill, (PCC) regarding Safeguarding

- In accordance with the House of Bishops' Policy Statements 'Promoting a Safer Church' (2017) and 'Protecting All God's Children' (2010) and the Diocesan Safeguarding Policy 'Promoting a Safer Diocese' (2018) our PCC is committed to:
  - Promoting a safer environment and culture.
  - Safely recruiting and supporting all those with any responsibility related to children, young people and vulnerable adults within our churches.
  - Responding promptly to every safeguarding concern or allegation.
  - Caring pastorally for victims/survivors of abuse and other affected persons.
  - Caring pastorally for those who are the subject of concerns or allegations of abuse and other affected persons.
  - Responding to those that may pose a present risk to others.

#### **Clay Hill Safeguarding Policy Statement**

- 2. The PCC will:
- Create a safe and caring place for all.
- Have a named Church Safeguarding Officer (CSO) to work with the Incumbent and the PCC to implement policy and procedures.
- Safely recruit, train and support all those with any responsibility for children, young
  people and adults to have the confidence and skills to recognise and respond to
  abuse.
- Ensure that there is appropriate insurance cover for all activities involving children and adults undertaken in the name of the PCC.
- Display in church premises and on the parish website the details of who to contact if there are safeguarding concerns or support needs.
- Listen to and take seriously all those who disclose abuse.
- Take steps to protect children and adults when a safeguarding concern of any kind arises, following House of Bishops guidance, including notifying the Diocesan Safeguarding Adviser (DSA) and statutory agencies immediately.
- Offer support to victims/survivors of abuse regardless of the type of abuse, when or where it occurred.
- Care for and monitor any member of the community of our churches who may pose a
  risk to children and adults whilst maintaining appropriate confidentiality and the safety
  of all parties.
- Ensure that health and safety policy, procedures and risk assessments are in place and that these are reviewed annually.
- Review the implementation of the Safeguarding Policy, Procedures and Practices at least annually.
- 3. Each person who works within the community of our churches will agree to abide by this policy and the guidelines established by this PCC.
- 4. The PCC appoints Cheryl Graham as the Church Safeguarding Officer for our parish of St John and St Luke, Clay Hill.
